Context and Aim of the Workshop: A recently conducted market assessment by EACREEE and U4E has shown that today many inefficient products circulate in the markets of Eastern Africa. These products consume unnecessary large amounts of electricity and are responsible for causing an added strain on the electricity grid. A key tool to transform the markets to energy-efficient products are Product Registration Systems. Without Product Registration Systems a market cannot be monitored to what is really sold on the ground. In other words, policies, such as Minimum Energy Performance Standards (MEPS), can be implemented but if there is no surveillance of the products imported and sold, these policies are not effective on the ground. This workshop aims to raise awareness on the tool and inform participates on the need for, and benefits of, Product Registration Systems. Moreover, possibilities for implementing a system, such as through an available and free of charge prototype, are presented.

Targeted Participants: Representatives from Ministries and public organizations, such as Energy Ministries, Customs, Trade, Regulatory offices. Private sector, such as producers, retailers and importers of lighting, appliance, and equipment. Interested stakeholders from the region, such as from universities. International organizations and representatives from projects working on the topic of energy-efficiency.
