Context

Energy efficiency is “the first fuel” for energy security and alleviating energy poverty while reducing GHGs. Actions discussed will include applying U4E's Model Regulations through voluntary financial mechanisms, mandatory MEPS and labels, regional policy harmonisation, and market transformation approaches.
