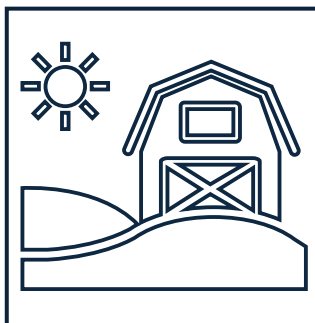
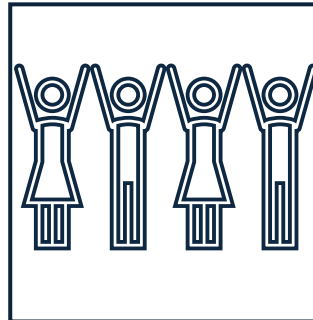


# EmPower and ACE Work Focus



1. Asia-Pacific actors increase climate action in a gender responsive manner

2. Representation of women and vulnerable groups in decision-making processes on climate, renewable energy and disaster risk reduction

---

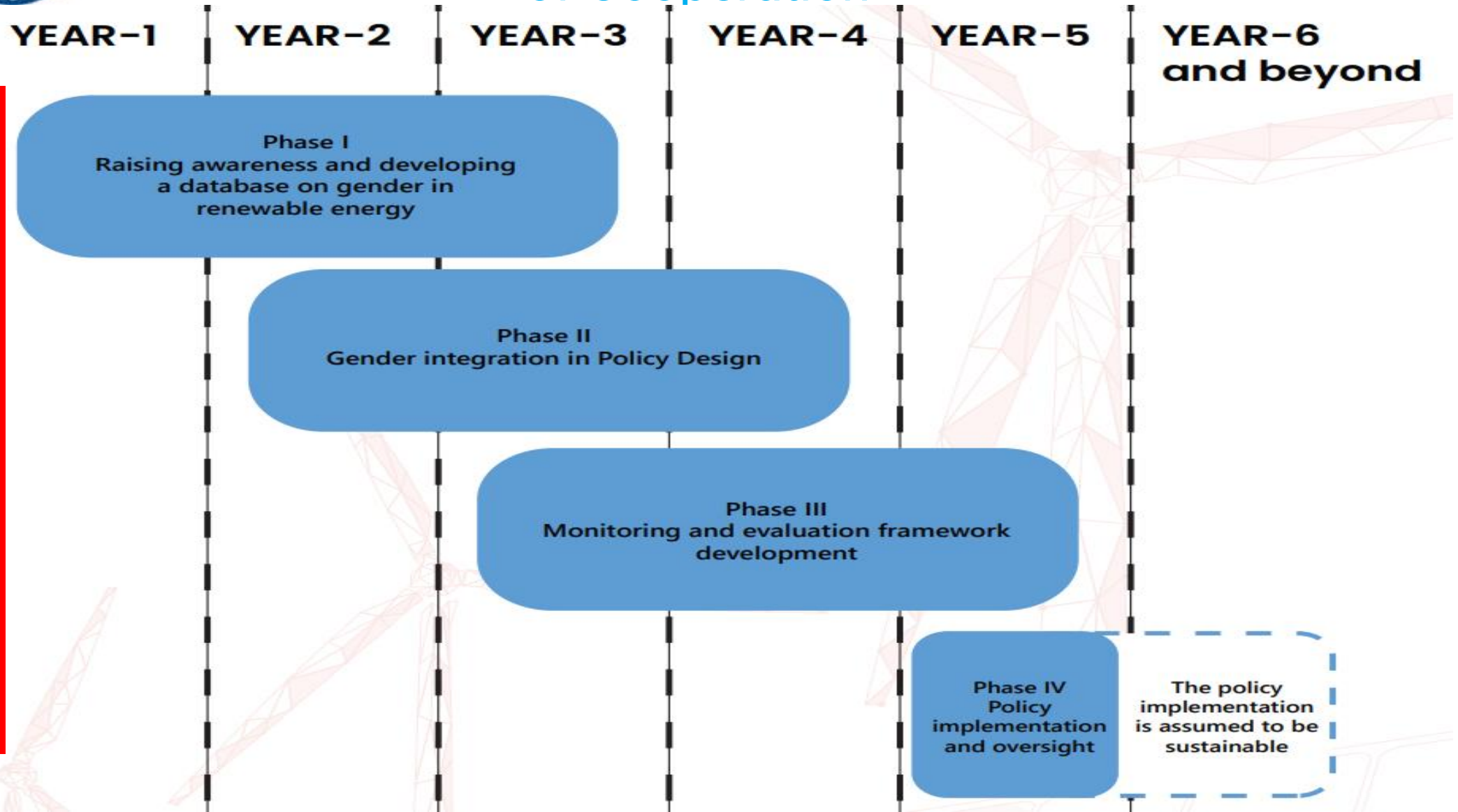
Establishing **pro-poor, inclusive, gender- and climate-responsive approaches** in integrated policy frameworks
